### Maths

Count a set of objects by saying one number name for each object.

Understand that numbers identify how many objects are in a set.

Begin to understand the language of weight including 'heavy' and 'light'.

Begin to match the correct numeral with an amount of objects.

### English

Repeat words and phrases from familiar stories.

Fill in the missing word in well known rhymes.

Listen to and join in with stories and poems.

Distinguish between the marks I make.

Give meaning to marks as I draw and paint.

### Personal, Social and Emotional

#### Development

Show confidence in speaking to others about my own needs, interests and opinions.

Show friendly behaviour by talking to friends and family or adults.

### Understanding the World

Begin to notice detailed features of objects in my environment.

Talk about some of the things I have observed such as plants, animals and natural objects.

### Communication and Language

Join in with repeated refrains and anticipate key events in rhymes and stories.

Respond to simple instructions e.g. to get or put away an object.
